All-State:

Branson Choir Trip:

Homecoming Parade:

Homecoming Parade is Monday, Oct. 10th. The school theme is "Once Upon a Time". There will be a community Pep Rally after the parade at 7:30pm in the football stadium; choir will be singing the Star-Spangled Banner.

The first Choir Social was held Aug. 27th at The Keller Pointe. A parent Meet & Greet Social was also held at the same time indoors and was a huge success! There were about 25 parents in attendance. We're looking into holding this event every year.

Booster Membership:

We kicked off our booster sign-up at choir registration on Saturday, Aug. 27th, and currently have 94 members in support of our choir program. Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

For a student to be eligible for a scholarship their senior year, these requirements must be met throughout their high school career:

• Parents must be a member of the choir booster club at least 2 of the 4 years that their child is in high school (minimum donation of \$50), and

- Parents must volunteer 15 hours in each of those two years (or 30 hours can be served across the 4 years of high school), or
- Parents can donate at the Maestro level or higher in each of those two years to waive the volunteer hours requirement (minimum of \$250)

SignUp.com will be our system of record for event volunteer hours, and booster meetings will count toward hours. Special circumstances may be considered for scholarships.

The Choir Booster Board hopes you will join us in supporting our kids and this incredible program. Not only will you be helping the choir, but you will have a lot of fun doing it alongside other parents just like you. It's a great way to get out, meet new people, and make new friends!

Tom Thumb:

Link your Tom Thumb Reward card to our Good Neighbor Number 6979.

Here's how it works: Simply fill out the Good Neighbor program section and the top part of a Reward Card Application, indicating your organization's number **6979** and return it to the Courtesy Booth. That's it! KHS Choir is now linked to your card. From that point on, the purchase price of groceries will automatically be recorded to KHS Choir Good Neighbor account. Tom Thumb will send us a check for 1% of the total each guarter.

If you already have a Reward card linked to an organization, you can change your designated organization at any time by completing a Reward Application form at any Courtesy Booth. Fill in the top portion and the "Good Neighbor Program" section, indicating account number **6979.** You will now be linked to KHS Choir.

Here's how it works:
