Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

For a student to be eligible for a scholarship their senior year, these requirements must be met throughout their high school career:

 Parents must be a member of the choir booster club at least 2 of the 4 years that their child is in high school with a minimum donation of \$50

AND

Parents must volunteer a minimum of 15 hours in each of the two years*
Parents can be a member of the choir booster club with a donation of \$250 or higher in each of those two years to waive the volunteer hours requirement.

Scholarship Eligibility for SEG:

- Parents must be a member of the Booster club for that academic year.
- Parents must volunteer at a minimum of 10 hours for that academic year.

SignUp.Com will be our system of record for event volunteer hours and attendance at booster meetings will count toward volunteer hours (1 hour credit per meeting).

Special circumstances may be considered for scholarships.

The choir booster board hopes you will join us in supporting our kids and this incredible program. Not only will you be helping the choir, but you will have a lot of fun volunteering alongside other parents just like you. It's a great way to get out, meet new people and make new friends! 
